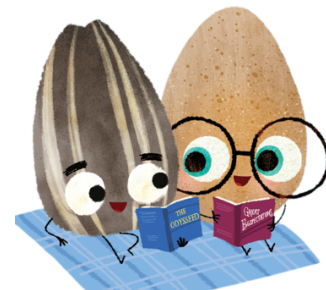

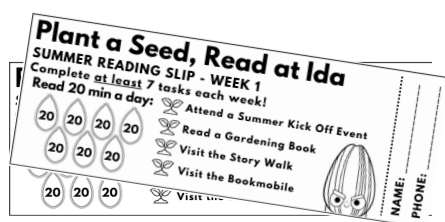
SUMMER READING PROGRAM

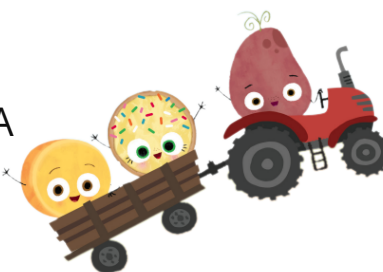

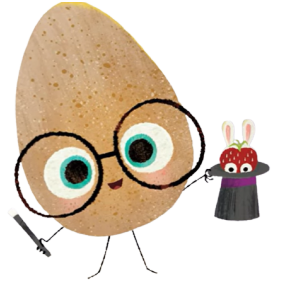

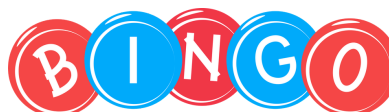


BELVIDERE'S HERO MOVIE SHOWING

BLESSING BOX

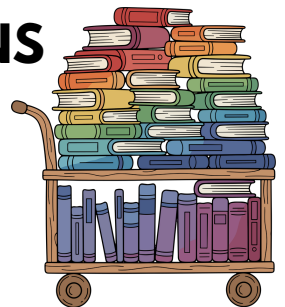
